

Outfit Planning Terms of Use

These terms describe the rules for using Wador to browse curated looks and pieces, save shortlists, plan outfits on a calendar, receive local reminders, answer an optional style questionnaire, and open spatial previews where three-dimensional assets are available. You may open and use Wador without registering or logging into a mandatory account.

Chapter 01

Binding effect of these terms

By downloading, opening, or continuing to use Wador, you agree to follow these Outfit Planning Terms of Use. If you do not agree, you should stop using the application and remove it from your device. These terms work together with the Personal Wardrobe Data Practices Notice that explains how information is handled inside Wador.

Chapter 02

Eligibility to open the wardrobe

You may use Wador if you have the legal capacity to enter a binding agreement under applicable law and if you comply with the rules of the app marketplace through which you obtained the software. Wador is aimed at a general audience. If you are under the age where local law requires guardian consent for digital services, you should use Wador only with appropriate permission from a parent or legal guardian.

No sign-up flow is required to browse looks, save pieces, or maintain a personal schedule on your device. Features that rely on local storage operate on the handset you are using.

Chapter 03

What Wador offers in practice

Wador is an outfit browsing, saving, and planning tool. Within the app you can typically:

- Explore recommended looks and individual garments across styles, weather contexts, and occasions.
- Search and filter wardrobe content, then open detail screens for pieces and complete outfits.
- Save content to a personal shortlist for later review.
- Place looks or pieces on calendar dates, edit or remove those plans, and set a preferred local reminder time.
- Complete or retake an optional style questionnaire that influences how recommendations are prioritized.
- Open augmented or three-dimensional previews on supported content, including rotating models and placing them in physical space where the device allows.

Wador is not presented as a traditional retail checkout destination. Descriptions of garments and looks are provided for inspiration and planning. Availability of any particular look, piece, filter, reminder, or spatial preview may vary by device capability and content package.

Chapter 04

License boundaries for the software

Subject to these terms, we grant you a limited, personal, non-exclusive, non-transferable, revocable license to install and use Wador on devices you own or control, solely for your own wardrobe browsing and planning. You may not copy the application for redistribution, reverse engineer it except where mandatory law permits, rent or sublicense it, or use it to build a competing product by extracting its content libraries, models, or interface patterns.

All rights not expressly granted remain reserved. Platform store rules that apply to your download also continue to bind you.

Chapter 05

Acceptable use while browsing and planning

When you use Wador, you agree that you will not:

- Interfere with the normal operation of the app, its reminders, or its preview sessions through malware, automated scraping that overloads the client, or deliberate corruption of local data structures.
- Attempt to bypass technical limits that gate certain preview or planning actions inside the product.
- Use camera, microphone, or photo-library access for purposes unrelated to the styling and preview flows Wador presents, or in ways that violate other people's rights.
- Misrepresent Wador content as your own commercial catalog, or remove proprietary notices from screens, assets, or models.
- Use the application in any manner that is unlawful, harassing, or that encourages harm to others.

We may suspend access to particular features on a device if we reasonably believe these rules are being violated, to the extent such controls are technically available.

Chapter 06

Notes and materials you create

Wador may let you attach short notes to looks and keep planning labels on calendar entries. Those texts remain under your control on the device. You are responsible for making sure your notes do not include unlawful content, confidential information you are not entitled to store, or material that infringes someone else's rights.

Because these materials are primarily local, we do not claim ownership of the wording you type into notes. You grant only the limited permission needed for Wador to display and store that wording on your device as part of the planning features you chose to use.

Chapter 07

Intellectual property in looks and branding

The Wador name, visual design, interface layouts, curated outfit presentations, product photography, descriptive copy, and three-dimensional garment assets are protected by intellectual property laws and remain the property of their respective owners. Your license to use the app does not transfer ownership of those materials to you.

You may view and use the content inside Wador for personal outfit inspiration and planning. You may not republish the asset libraries, scrape model files for commercial reuse, or create derivative public catalogs from Wador's curated sets without prior written permission from the rights holder.

Chapter 08

Outside materials and platform services

Spatial preview, notifications, camera capture, and marketplace distribution depend on operating-system components and third-party frameworks. Those components are governed by their own terms. Wador does not control every behavior of the underlying camera stack, notification center, or storefront environment.

Links or embedded views that open hosted documents (such as policy pages) are provided for convenience. External pages may follow separate rules once you leave the native wardrobe screens.

Feature timing: the present version of these Outfit Planning Terms of Use applies beginning **August 4, 2026**. Please treat that calendar date as the reference point for the commitments described in this document.

Chapter 09

Changes and availability of features

We may update Wador to adjust look catalogs, filters, reminder behavior, questionnaire options, preview assets, or interface arrangement. Some features may be added, limited, or retired as the product evolves or as device support changes. We will use commercially reasonable efforts to keep core browsing and planning usable, but we do not promise uninterrupted access or permanent availability of any single look, model, or reminder channel.

If these terms themselves change in a material way, the updated text will be made available through the in-app document link or an equivalent channel. Continued use after an update constitutes acceptance of the revised terms where permitted by law.

Chapter 10

Practical risks of planning and preview tools

Outfit recommendations, filters, and questionnaire results are aids for personal styling decisions. They are not professional fashion advice, safety certifications, or guarantees that a garment will fit, suit an event, or match real-world lighting and fabric behavior.

Spatial previews approximate how a piece may appear in your surroundings. Results can vary with device sensors, lighting, surface detection, and model fidelity. Use care when moving around while a camera-based preview is active, and do not rely on the preview as a substitute for trying garments in person when fit or safety matters.

Local reminders depend on operating-system notification delivery and correct device time zone settings. Missed or delayed alerts can occur for reasons outside Wador's control.

Chapter 11

Limits on responsibility

To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, Wador and its operators are not liable for indirect, incidental, special, consequential, or punitive damages, or for lost profits, lost data, or business interruption arising from your use of or inability to use the application, including reliance on outfit suggestions, calendar plans, reminders, or spatial previews.

Where liability cannot be excluded, it is limited to the maximum extent allowed by law. Some jurisdictions do not allow certain limitations; in those places, the limits apply only as far as legally enforceable. Nothing in these terms excludes liability that cannot be limited under mandatory consumer protection rules.

Chapter 12

Ending your use of Wador

You may stop using Wador at any time by closing the app and uninstalling it. Uninstalling typically removes local shortlists, schedules, notes, and preference data according to how your operating system manages application storage.

We may discontinue the application or particular features, or restrict use that violates these terms, when we have a legitimate reason to do so. Provisions that by their nature should survive (including intellectual property, liability limits, and dispute terms) continue after you stop using Wador.

Chapter 13

Disputes and governing law

These Outfit Planning Terms of Use are governed by the laws of the United States, without applying conflict-of-law rules that would point to another jurisdiction. Any dispute arising out of or relating to these terms or your use of Wador shall be brought before competent dispute resolution bodies under applicable law.
